“Water Treatment Plant Borrowing Bylaw No. 489”

To borrow money for the purpose of the construction of a water treatment plant and reservoir located at 1723 Cedar Rd.

By completing this Elector Response Form I certify that:

- I am a person entitled to be registered as an elector (pursuant to the Local Government Act and Letters Patent) within the North Cedar Improvement District and own property eligible to be connected or connected to the District’s water system. Properties not serviced by water and that do not pay the water parcel tax are not eligible to vote;
- I have not previously signed an Elector Response Form with respect to this Bylaw; and
- I am **OPPOSED** to the adoption of “Water Treatment Plant Borrowing Bylaw No. 489” to finance the construction costs, equipment costs, infrastructure upgrades, commissioning and other associated project costs of a new water treatment plant and reservoir on the District’s property at 1723 Cedar Road, Nanaimo, unless the assent of the electors in a voting proceeding (referendum) is obtained.

If at least 10% (310) of eligible electors sign and submit a completed Elector Response Form by the deadline, the North Cedar Improvement District may not proceed with adopting “Water Treatment Plant Borrowing Bylaw No. 489” unless elector approval is obtained by assent voting (referendum).

INFORMATION REGARDING QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELECTORS

- A Canadian Citizen;
- Eighteen (18) years of age or older;
- An owner of land in the improvement district that is connected or eligible to be connected to the water and pays the water parcel tax, and
- A resident of the province for the prior six months; or
- A person designated – in writing – to act as an authorized agent by a board or corporation that owns land in the District. The corporation must be registered in British Columbia and the agent must be qualified in vote in BC. Proof of such must be in the form of a letter from a lawyer or the corporations BC business registration number; or
- A legal representative of an owner of land in the improvement district who has died, become insolvent or insane.
