RE: Lifting of Moratorium on New Water Connections Effective September 1, 2021

The District has now received the permit from Island Health and the building permit from the Regional District of Nanaimo. Construction has started on the water treatment plant and 1000 cubic meter reservoir, located at 1723 Cedar Road and it is anticipated that the treatment plant will be operational by year end.

The Board motioned at the December 10, 2020 meeting that the Board revisit the moratorium list once the treatment plant and reservoir design are at 100% and a time line for construction has been firmly set. At the regular board meeting of Thursday July 8, 2021, the Board motioned to lift the water moratorium and start allowing connections to the water system on September 1, 2021. This means that those on the wait list may proceed with any engineering or work required to prepare for connection on or after September 1, 2021. As well those within District boundaries wishing to connect to the system may contact the District to start the process for applying for a connection.
