Watering Restrictions

STAGE 4 In Effective Tuesday, July 13, 2021

Last week the province announced that most of eastern Vancouver Island is now at Drought Level 4. With low rainfall and extreme heat in June and July the District has made the decision to move to Stage 4 watering restrictions, to prompt further reduction of water demand. Following watering conservation and restrictions are critical in order to maintain water supply for fire protection, essential household use and environmental flows in streams.

Under Stage 4 Watering Restrictions lawn watering and sprinklers are banned. Washing of vehicles, boats, houses, sidewalks and driveways is not permitted. Hand watering of trees, shrubs, flowers, gardens and fruit trees is permitted.
